Summary:

A level 1 operator is an entry level position that will be involved in various aspects of golf maintenance. These basic tasks are the day to day tasks that must be accomplished to ensure that the golf course is maintained at the level that we would expect. Golf Course experience is an asset, and although a level 1 position is entry level, it is an integral position.

Responsibilities:

- Setting the golf course for the day including emptying garbage, changing tee blocks and moving ropes.
- Bunker maintenance.
- Trimming, mowing, gardening and mulching.
- Operate within set safety guidelines.
- Additional duties may be assigned as required.

Qualifications:

- Able to demonstrate a growing knowledge of equipment operation as time progresses.
- Self motivated. Strong performer.
- Able to positively interact with co-workers, and public.
- An understanding of the game of golf is an asset.
- Regularly required to stand, walk, bend, sit, and reach with hands.
- Ability to lift/move objects up to 50 lbs.
- Able to work outdoors in all weather conditions.
